Student Contract & Terms and Conditions – 30-Hour Yin Yoga Teacher Training

This policy outlines the core requirements and expectations for all trainees enrolled in the 30-hour Yin Yoga Teacher Training with Joy Yoga and Wellness. By joining the programme, you agree to uphold these terms and meet the standards required for certification.

Prerequisites

Applicants should have a consistent yoga practice and be willing to explore Yin methodology with openness and commitment.

Accreditation

Upon successful completion, trainees receive a certificate from Joy Yoga and Wellness. Your contact details may be shared with relevant accreditation bodies unless you choose to opt out.

Attendance & Missed Hours

Full attendance is expected to ensure you meet the required contact hours. Missed content must be made up through additional study or a catch-up session, subject to tutor approval and catch-up fees. Missing substantial portions of the course may require joining a future training.

Practice, Assignments & Assessment

Trainees are expected to maintain a regular practice, complete all assignments, and participate fully in practical and theoretical learning. All coursework must be submitted on time; late submissions may incur an admin fee. Graduation is dependent on completing all requirements and demonstrating safe, competent teaching skills.

Ethical Standards

Students must uphold respectful conduct, yogic principles, and professional behaviour. Any behaviour that compromises safety, integrity, inclusivity, or the learning environment may affect certification.

Online Learning

If required, some sessions may be delivered online. Participation in recorded livestreams implies consent for your image and voice to be included in training materials, which will not be used for promotional purposes.

Changes to Course Delivery

In unforeseen circumstances (e.g., extreme weather, venue issues), training may shift online or be adjusted. Refunds are not provided due to delivery changes.

Complaints & Deferral

Complaints must be submitted in writing. Deferral may be granted for significant absence or extenuating circumstances, subject to availability and any applicable fees.

Tuition Fees

Full course fee:

- **£1,350** – Ensuite room
- **£1,100** – Twin shared occupancy

A **30% deposit** is required to secure your place. The remaining balance is due **2 months before the course start date**. Deposits are non-refundable once your place is confirmed.

Payment Plans

Instalment options are available upon request. Once agreed, payment schedules must be followed. All fees must be paid in full for graduation.

Cancellation Policy

No refunds, transfers, or credits are offered before, during, or after the course start date. Enrolling commits you to paying the full course fee, regardless of completion.
